§1 General

- 1. With the entry of a member the association takes up his name, his address, his age, his email address and his bank account, as well as the data of the respective dog. This information will be stored in the association's own computer systems of the data entry office, the association's board and the office. Each member of the association is assigned a membership number. The personal data is protected from third parties by suitable technical and organizational measures.
- 2. Other information (e.g. telephone and fax numbers) and information on non-members shall in principle only be processed internally by the association if it is useful for promoting the association's purpose and there is no indication that the data subject has an interest worthy of protection which conflicts with the processing.
- 3. As a VDH/FCI recognized club, the EKW is a member of the IFEZ, with which it only exchanges dog data, but no personal data.
- 4. Within the association, the members of the board and other members who have a special function in the association have access to the dog data as well as to the personal data of the members, as far as this is necessary for their work (see paragraph 1). This group of persons is only authorized to use the data by the written assurance that the passing on of the data, except for breeding purposes within the association, is prohibited.

§2 Public relations

- 1. The club informs the members via the club newsletter about show results, festivities and special events. Such information shall also be published on the Association's website.
- 2. The individual member may object to such publication at any time vis-à-vis the Executive Board. In the event of an objection, no further publications will be made with regard to the objecting member, with the exception of the results of exhibitions or association events. Personal data of the objecting member will be removed from the homepage of the association.

§3 Disclosure of membership data to association members

- 1. Membership lists or personal data, are handed out only to members of the board and other members who exercise a special function in the association, which requires knowledge of the membership data. If a member claims that he/she needs the list of members to exercise his/her statutory rights, the Executive Board will only hand over the list in return for a written assurance that the addresses will not be used for other purposes.
- 2. Upon resignation, the name, address, year of birth and email address of the member will be deleted from the membership list.
- 3. Personal data of the resigning member, concerning the cash administration, will be kept for up to ten years from the written confirmation of the resignation by the board, in accordance with the provisions of the tax law.

§4 Declaration of consent

Each member has to sign a declaration of consent regarding the data processing procedures and send it to the board of directors or the office
